Commissioner Leckie was sworn into office for his first term by Skamania County Auditor, Robert Waymire.

Commissioner Leckie moved, Commissioner Mahar stepped down and seconded the motion to appoint Commissioner Lannen as the Chair of the Board of Commissioners for 2023. The motion carried unanimously. Commissioner Lannen then took over the duties of running the meeting in his new role as Chair.

Commissioner Mahar moved to approve, seconded by Commissioner Leckie, and the motion carried unanimously to approve the Consent Agenda as follows:

- 2. Resolution 2023-01, Revisions to Chapter 1, Chapter 10, and Chapter 13 of the Personnel Policy to make clear the intent of benefits for employees when they become elected officials.

Walk-In agenda item - Commissioner Mahar moved to approve, seconded by Commissioner Lannen, and the motion carried unanimously to approve the revised job description and set salary at range 29 for Undersheriff.

Commissioner Mahar moved, seconded by Commissioner Leckie and the motion carried unanimously to approve vouchers for the period dated January 4th, 2023, in the total amount of \$34,420.68 with \$5,391.73 being Current Expense, covering warrant numbers 190414 through 190437.

Commissioner Leckie moved, seconded by Commissioner Mahar and the motion carried unanimously to approve the listing of 2023 Commissioner Assignments.

The Board held a workshop with Leana Kinley, City Administrator for the City of Stevenson, and Undersheriff Tracy Wyckoff in place of Sheriff Summer Scheyer, to discuss the extension of law enforcement services. The Board came out of the workshop and Commissioner Lannen moved, seconded by Commissioner Mahar and the motion carried unanimously to approve the Sheriff with the means of extending the contract that is currently in place with the City of Stevenson for law enforcement services.

The meeting recessed at 11:08 a.m. and reconvened the same day at 2:02 p.m. with Commissioners Asa Leckie and Richard Mahar present. Commissioner T.W. Lannen, Chair, was absent.

Walk-In agenda item - Commissioner Mahar moved to approve, seconded by Commissioner Lannen, and the motion carried unanimously to approve the professional service contract between Skamania County and the Law Office of Christopher R. Lanz for Public Defense Administrator.
