**BEFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
SKAMANIA COUNTY, WASHINGTON**

In the Matter of Amending the Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program

WHEREAS, unanticipated State funds are available to fund road surface treatments to maintain county roads but requires the project to be included in the County's current Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program pursuant to the requirements of the County Road Administration Board; and

WHEREAS, adding the Surface Treatment Project requires this amendment to the 2023-2028 Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, this Amended 2023–2028 Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program has been submitted to the Board of County Commissioners by the County Engineer in accordance with RCW 36.81.121 and WAC 136-15; and

WHEREAS, a priority array of potential projects on the county's road system and the 2022 Bridge Inspection Report was proposed by the County Engineer and available to the Board of Commissioners during the preparation of this program; and

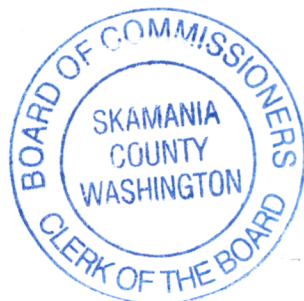
WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has received and inspected said program, reports and priorities and made changes and additions as deemed necessary; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing as required by statute was held on August 15, 2023 in the Commissioners' Meeting Room in the Skamania County Courthouse, Stevenson, Washington.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Skamania County, Washington hereby adopts the Amended 2023-2028 Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program and do hereby direct the County Engineer to proceed with the designated projects.
