WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has received and inspected said program, reports and priorities and made changes and additions as deemed necessary; and

**WHEREAS,** a public hearing as required by statue was held on August 15, 2023 in the Commissioners' Meeting Room in the Skamania County Courthouse, Stevenson, Washington.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of County Commissioners of Skamania County, Washington hereby adopts the Amended 2023-2028 Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program and do hereby direct the County Engineer to proceed with the designated projects.
