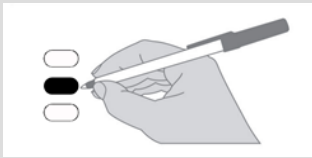


## Instructions

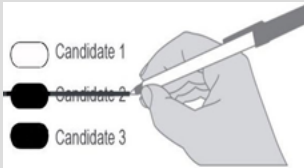
### How to vote

Vote for one in each race. If you vote for more than one, no votes will be counted for that race.

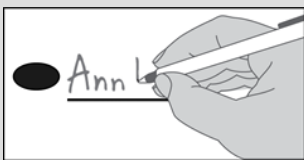
### How to correct a mistake

The Board of Skamania County  
Fire Protection District No. 1  
adopted Resolution No. 2023-05  
concerning a proposition to  
maintain and adequately fund  
District Operations.

This proposition would authorize  
the District to restore its current  
regular tax rate to \$1.00 per \$1,000  
dollars of assessed valuation to be  
collected beginning January 2024.  
This increase will be permanent  
and will establish a new dollar  
amount for the purpose of  
computing the limitations  
imposed by RCW 84.55.010 for  
subsequent levies. Proceeds would  
be used to maintain current  
operations and to proactively plan  
for the ever increasing needs and  
service demands of the  
communities served by the  
District.
