٠	Willard Bridge (No. 303)	AASHTO Type 3 25T; Type 3S2 34T; Type 3-3 38T; SUV4 27T; SUV5 30T; SUV6-7 30T

•	OK Ranger Station Bridge (No. 307)	SUV4 27T; SUV5 31T; SUV6-7 31T
•	Northwestern Lake Bridge (No. 309)	Per Klickitat County Engineer, remove loaded trucks one-way traffic based on their latest bridge inspection report and load rating summary.
