Minutes for Meeting of January 3rd, 2024

The Commissioners' business meeting was called to order at 9:31 a.m. on January 3rd, 2024, at the Commissioners' Meeting Room, 240 NW Vancouver Avenue in Stevenson, WA with Commissioner Asa Leckie, Commissioner Richard Mahar, and Commissioner T.W. Lannen, Chair, present.

The Pledge of the Allegiance was led by Lisa Sackos, Clerk of the Board.

Due to technical difficulties, the meeting recessed at 9:34 a.m. and reconvened the same day at 9:40 a.m. with Commissioners Asa Leckie, Richard Mahar, and T.W. Lannen, Chair, present.

There was no public comment.

Commissioner Mahar moved, Commissioner Lannen, Chair, stepped down and seconded the motion to appoint Commissioner Leckie as the Chair of the Skamania County Board of Commissioners for 2024. The motion carried unanimously. Commissioner Leckie then took over the duties of running the meeting in his new role as Chair.

Commissioner Lannen moved, Commissioner Leckie, Chair, stepped down and seconded the motion to appoint Commissioner Lannen as the Vice-Chair of the Board of Commissioners for 2024. The motion carried unanimously.

Commissioner Lannen moved, seconded by Commissioner Mahar, and the motion carried unanimously to approve vouchers for the period dated January 3rd, 2024, in the total amount of \$29,612.49 with \$4,738.44 being Current Expense, covering warrant numbers 196075 through 196100.


The Board reported on various meetings they attended.

Commissioner Lannen moved, seconded by Commissioner Mahar, and the motion carried unanimously to authorize the Chair to provide a letter to Eric Johnson with WSAC explaining the County's inability to provide funding to support NACO's proposed National Center for Public Land Counties effort.

The meeting adjourned at 10:24 a.m.




