Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a resident of Clark, Cowlitz, Lewis, Skamania, or Wahkiakum County.
- Knowledge about air quality and the protection of public health is preferred.

Compensation:

Board members receive \$50 for each meeting attended and are reimbursed for mileage.
