The total Current Expense spending authority requested not covered by increased revenues or other budget offsets is \$610,997.27

\$740.97 – External Services – Current Expense Fund (0010.360) – Computer replacement invoice was not sent to Commissioners' office in 2019 payment. It was noticed that it was not paid in 2019 and the bill still needs to be paid to ER & R. 2020 Computer Replacement Costs for WSU are \$307.48.

\$1,954.45 External Services – Current Expense Fund (0010.360) - The Commissioners met individually with Hannah Brause of WSU on February 11, 2020. She asked that \$954.45 be added to Intergovernmental Professional Services for Salaries and \$1,000 be added for office and operating costs.
