## DETERMINATION OF SIGNIFICANCE AND

### REQUEST FOR COMMENTS ON SCOPE OF ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT

FILE NUMBER:	SEP-21-15
DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSAL:	Proposed surface mining operation for the production and processing of aggregate resources including drilling, blasting, loading, hauling, crushing, screening, stockpiling, and commercial sales of crushed aggregate. The project will include a small operations and storage area, as well as the improvement and maintenance of an access road along the BPA corridor to the southwest.
	The total permit area will be 273.6 acres. Surface mining will be divided into two segments: mine segment 1, at the north end of the site, with an approximate area of 140.4 acres, and mine segment 2, with an approximate area of 8.8 acres. Per guidelines established by the DNR, the mine segments will be mined in sequence - with reclamation, replacement of topsoil, and re-vegetation occurring as mining is completed in each segment. Topsoil from both areas will be stored in perimeter berms. Overburden and additional topsoil will be stockpiled in a graded area at the center of the site, the construction of which will involve cut and fill methods to achieve a level area. All mining disturbance will be reclaimed back to commercial forestry upon the completion of mining activities.

 Transportation, including analysis of impacts to traffic, impacts to the existing road system, impacts to pedestrians, and impacts of noise.

Agencies, affected tribes, and members of the public are invited to comment on the scope of the EIS. You may comment on alternatives, mitigation measures, probable significant adverse impacts, and licenses or other approvals that may be required.
