

To align with Washington State Department of Health: "Case, hospitalization, and death counts include **both** confirmed and probable cases.

**Confirmed cases:** Are those where individuals had a positive molecular test result for COVID-19.

**Probable cases:** Are those where individuals had a positive antigen test result for COVID-19, but no positive molecular test result."

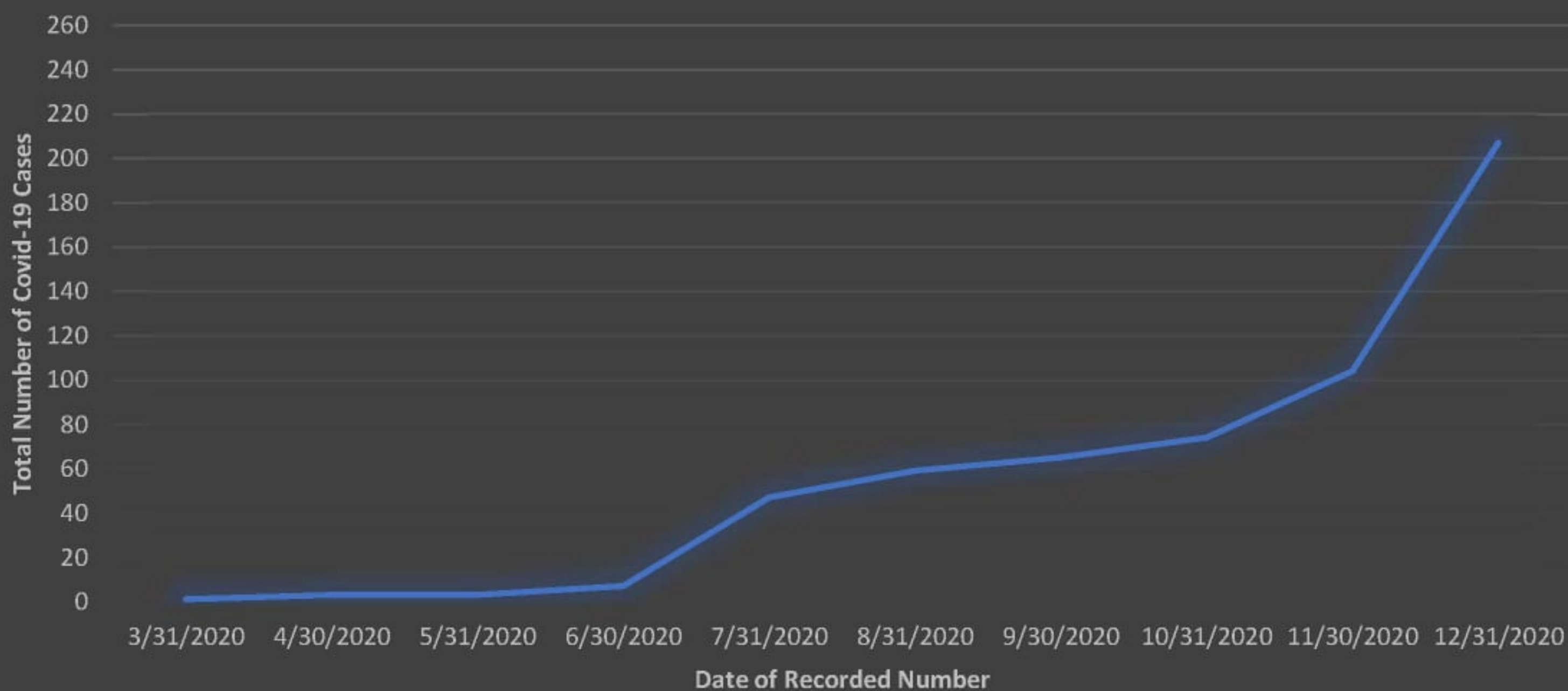
