COURT OPERATIONS UNDER THE EXIGENT CIRCUMSTANCES CREATED BY COVID-19 AND RELATED **CORONOVIRUS**

RENEWED AND CLARIFIED EMERGENCY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 20-10

WHEREAS, the above courts have previously entered emergency Administrative Orders due to COVID-19:

Whereas the Washington State Supreme Court has adopted emergency rules and granted further authority to this court to adopt, modify, and suspend court rules and orders and to take further actions concerning court operations, as warranted to address the current state of emergency:

And given the continued public health emergency in Washington caused by the Omicron Variant, significant number of identified and projected cases and the severity of risk posed to the public, lawyers and staff, and given the above public health recommendations from local public health authorities,

And given the facility limitations within the Skamania County Courthouse for meeting reasonable safety guidelines during the court's operations. COVID-19 EXTENDED EMERGENCY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 20-10 - 1

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that effective January 18, 2022:

- 1) Criminal jury trials from the date of this order through March 8, 2022 are stricken and continued, subject to rescheduling. Time for trial between the date of this order and any new trial date is excluded in computing time for trial.
- 2) Covid-19 continues to constitute an unavoidable circumstance under CrRLJ 3.3. The effective period of this order and of any continuances by this order will be excluded in computing time for trial under all applicable criminal rules and related local court rules. The period between January 18, 2022 and March 8, 2022 is an excluded period for calculating speedy trial for all pending criminal cases not set for trial. The court finds the ends of justice have been and continue to be served by continuing criminal cases, notwithstanding defendants' rights to a speedy trial.

The courts will continue docketing and mandating appearances for non-jury matters.

The Court will vacate or amend this Administrative Order no later than March 8, 2022.
