SUMMARY/BACKGROUND

The 2021 County Wide Safety and Wind River Road – Drainage, Slope Stability, Grind and Overlay Projects are numbers 5 and 6, consecutively, in the Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program 2022-2027. The intent of this Agenda Item is for the Board of Commissioners to approve Resolution No. 2022-04 authorizing the County Engineer to proceed with these projects.

- 2021 County Wide Safety project has a total amount of \$504,000.
- Wind River Road – Drainage, Slope Stability, Grind and Overlay, project has a budgeted total amount of \$3.75 million.

FISCAL IMPACT

The County's Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program 2022-2027 list the budget amount for Preliminary Engineering and Construction funding as follows:

- The 2021 County Wide Safety project has a budget amount of \$504,000 for this project. FHWA (Federal) Funds cover 100% of the project.
- The Wind River Road - Drainage Slope Stability, Grind and Overlay project has a budget amount of \$3.75 million for this project. FHWA (Federal) Funds covers \$2.625 million, CAPP (State) Funds covers \$375,000 and the County will allocate \$750,000 Local Funds for the project.

RECOMMENDATION

That the Board of County Board of Commissioners, by motion action, approves Resolution No. 2022-04 authorizing the County Engineer to proceed; thus, assigning CRP# 2022-01 to the 2021 County Wide Safety project and CRP# 2022-02 to the Wind River Drainage, Slope Stability, Grind and Overlay project.

AGENCY NO. 30

The agency agrees to comply with the following requirements when developing all Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) projects under Full CA status.


1. Adherence to the *Local Agency Guidelines* and all policies and procedures promulgated by the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) which accomplish the policies and objectives set forth in Title 23, U.S. Code, Highways, and the regulations issued pursuant thereto.
2. The overall approval authorities and conditions will be as follows:
 - a. The project prospectus will be reviewed and approved by the following official.
Chairman of the Board of Commissioners

 - b. The local agency agreement will be reviewed and approved by the following official or officials.
County Engineer

 - c. The designs and environmental documents will be reviewed and approved by the following state of Washington registered Professional Civil Engineer.

 - d. The hearing's findings (if required) will be reviewed and approved by the following official or officials.
Chairman of the Board of Commissioners

 - e. The contract plans, specifications and estimate of cost will be reviewed and approved by the following state of Washington registered Professional Engineer.

 - f. Agreements will be signed by the following responsible local official.
 - (1) Railroad Chairman of the Board of Commissioners

 - (2) Utility Chairman of the Board of Commissioners

 - (4) Technical Services Chairman of the Board of Commissioners

 - g. The award of contract will be signed by the following responsible local official.

All projects will be constructed in conformance with the Washington State Department of Transportation/American Public Works Association (WSDOT/APWA) current *Standard Specifications for Road, Bridge, and Municipal Construction* and such specifications that modify these specifications as appropriate. Multimodal enhancement projects shall be constructed in conformance with applicable state and local codes.


Certification Acceptance Qualification Agreement

- i. The contract administration will be supervised by the following state of Washington registered Professional Civil Engineer.
County Engineer

- j. Construction administration and material sampling and testing will be accomplished in accordance with the *WSDOT Construction Manual and the Local Agency Guidelines*.
3. The agency agrees that they have the means to provide adequate expertise and will have support staff available to perform the functions being subdelegated. The support staff may include consultant or state services.
4. The agency agrees that the signature on each project prospectus and local agency agreement will be consistent with section 2 above.
5. All projects under Certification Acceptance shall be available for review by the FHWA and the state at any time and all project documents shall be retained and available for inspection during the plan development and construction stages and for a three year period following acceptance of the project by WSDOT.
6. Approval of the local agency certification by the Assistant Secretary for Highways and Local Programs may be rescinded at any time upon local agency request or if, in the opinion of the Assistant Secretary for Highways and Local Programs, it is necessary to do so. The rescission may be applied to all or part of the programs or projects approved in the local agency certification.



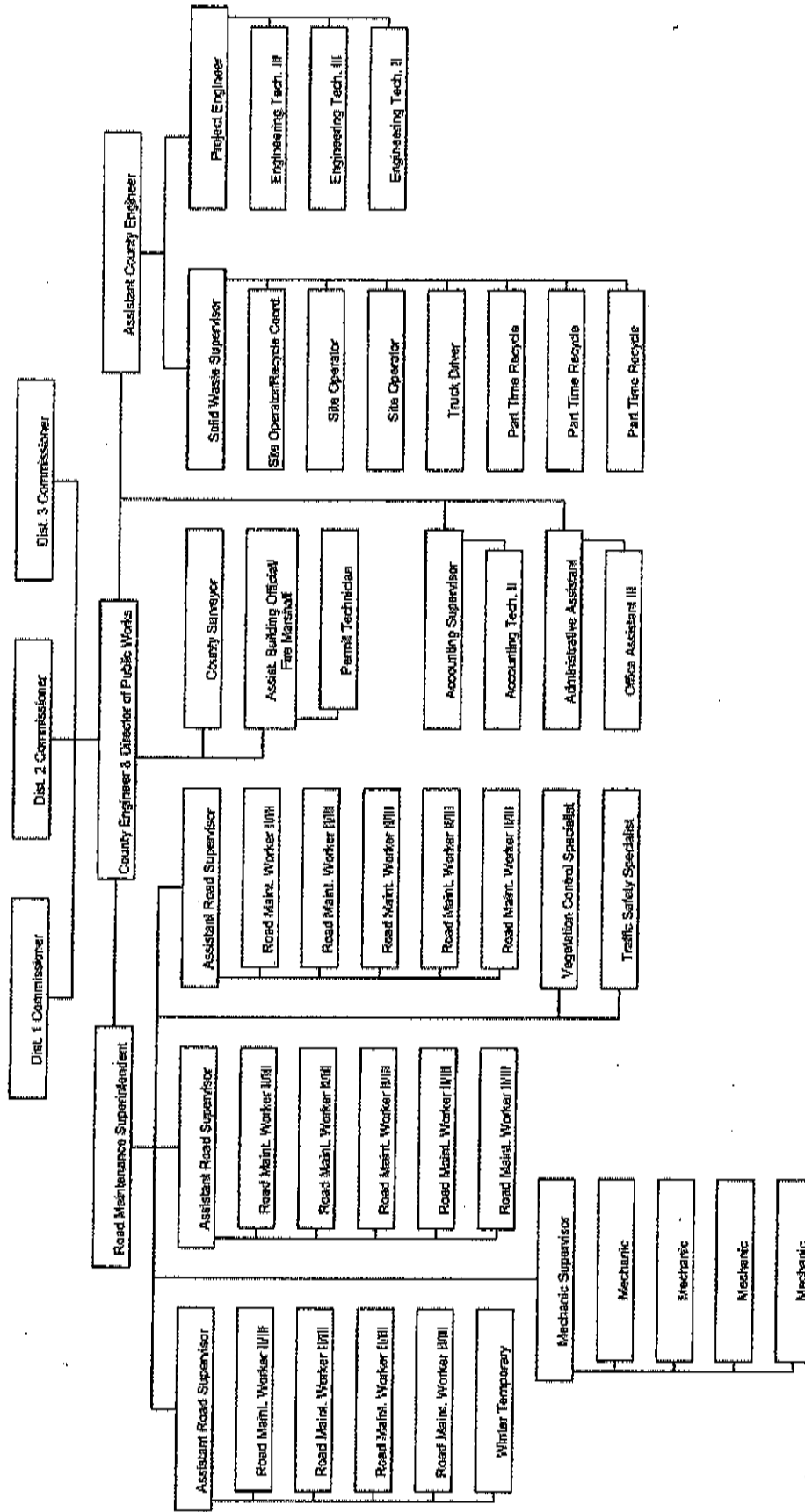

SUBJECT: Certification Acceptance (CA) Agreement Update

Date: December 6, 2002

SUMMARY:

Certification Acceptance (CA) is a program in which the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) delegates authority to Washington State Dept. Of Transportation (WSDOT) for approving project development and construction administration. WSDOT has the option of delegating some or all of this authority to qualified local agencies. This procedure certifies a local agency to execute more of the approval authority at the local level when developing FHWA assisted projects. This certification will result in savings in time and money since the agency has the authority to develop, advertise, award, and manage its own projects.

PREVIOUS COMMISSION ACTION:

- May 21, 1979, Chairman of the Board of Commissioners, Dean Evans, signed the previous Certification Acceptance Qualification Agreement.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The cost for administration of FHWA projects would be greatly increased if the local agency had to acquire the services of WSDOT or other CA agencies.

DISCUSSION:

Recently a letter was received from WSDOT Highways and Local Programs Division Director Kathleen B. Davis requesting that Skamania County submit and updated CA agreement. Apparently Skamania County's 1979 agreement is outdated. This is not a request to be certified but only to update the agreement to the revised form currently used by WSDOT.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners, by motion action, sign the Certification Acceptance Qualification Agreement.
