Planning

- Met with Alex Hays and City of Stevenson to discuss permitting requirements for fairgrounds well project.
- Public hearing before the Hearing Examiner on Monday, June 13th to consider preliminary plat approval for Grandview Estates Subdivision.
- Staff will prepare for Tuesday, June 21st Planning Commission meeting.
- Working on several short plats and subdivisions in various phases of development review. Muddy River Subdivision should appear on BOCC agenda for final subdivision plat approval soon.
- Current planning workload consists of short plat/subdivision applications, National Scenic Area development reviews, critical areas/shoreline reviews, and contract with Bingen.
